What curriculum topics are being covered this year?	Year 10 – HT1 - Equipment for 1 year to 5 years. HT2 – Nutritional guidelines from birth to 5 years. HT3 Investigate feeding solutions from birth to 5 years. HT4 - Revision of R018. HT5 Revision of R018. PUBLIC EXAMINATION – June. Coursework Unit R020 - Physical Intellectual and Social development Norms from birth to 5 years. HT6 Norms.
How many exams have students got and what is covered in each one?	Year 10 – Public Examination – external worth 50% of their final qualification grade. 1.25 hours usually in May/June. The exam will cover all the learning outcomes in the five booklets.
What should students be focusing on?	They should be focused on the coursework centred around the nursery initially, planning equipment that may be purchased for a new nursery and then the feeding options available for babies, and then revision. Students should then be focused on the knowledge and information that is taught in lesson in their 5 booklets. They will be given revision resources to help them retain the information. This could be in the form of a quick quiz or as a knowledge organiser that they have created in lesson. They can also access the student shared area which has resources on it.

Support your son or daughter by watching videos or using the websites below when they are completing homework, coursework, or revision. Attend the curriculum/parents' evenings during the year to gain a better understanding of your son or daughter's progress.
